GISS – Eleanor for sale.

LAS VEGAS - March 17, 2006: She's fast, fun and fabulous. She's Eleanor. And she's for sale.

Eleanor has returned to The Auto Collections at the Imperial Palace Hotel and Casino.

The 1967 Mustang GT500 stole the show in "Gone in Sixty Seconds," the 2000 action hit starring Nicolas Cage.

The popular pony car is actually one of 11 built for the movie. Of those, two were destroyed in the climactic bridge jump and junkyard crusher scenes. Because certain cars were needed to do different maneuvers in the film, no two Eleanors were alike.

All the Eleanors only acted the role of being Shelbys while really they were modified Mustang fastbacks. And, although in "Gone" the car is supposed to be a four-on-the-floor, most of the Eleanors were automatics -- because it's easier to act and do stunts when you don't have to manually shift gears.

The Mustang muscle magnet will remain on display between 9:30 a.m. and 5 p.m. Monday through Friday until it's sold. Eleanor was previously on display in June 2003 and remains one of the all-time most crowd-pleasing attractions in The Auto Collections.

The Auto Collections is the world's largest classic car lot with \$100 million worth of inventory on display and for sale. It includes antique, muscle, famous, infamous and historically significant vehicles. Open daily, 9:30 a.m. - 9:30 p.m. Tickets are \$6.95 for adults, \$3 for seniors and children 5-12 and children under 5 are free.

The Imperial Palace is home to the award-winning tribute show "Legends In Concert" and the Dealertainers(TM), celebrity impersonators who deal blackjack. Imperial Palace is the most central stop on the Las Vegas Monorail. In addition, the resort is famous for "Five-Star-Friendly Service" and includes a race and sports book, 2,640 rooms and suites, world-class gaming and amenities, a seasonal poolside luau, 40,000 square feet of meeting and banquet space, 10 specialty restaurants, 10 bars and lounges, state-of-the-art spa and fitness center, business center, concierge service, medical center, chapel and reception facilities.

Nicolas Cage's Superhero Saga 'Ghost Rider' on Hold

Looks like Nicolas Cage's Marvel Comic superhero saga, "Ghost Rider" is dematerializing before our very eyes. "It was supposed to come out this summer, but it's not coming out," says Sam Elliott, who costars in the film shot last year with Cage, Wes Bentley and Eva Mendes. "Sony took such a beating around the box office, they decided to hold it, and it's coming out on President's Day of '07," he says. February is not usually the time of year studios choose to release such action-genre films, so that doesn't bode well for "Ghost Rider" turning into a franchise for Cage. However, says Elliott, "I hope it does well. I happened to like Nicolas a lot. I think he's great at what he does, and once again, he's incredible in this thing." In the film, Elliott plays "a guy named Caretaker who takes care of the cemetery. Ghost Rider comes there seeking solace and safety, and I provide him with information." Should the box office warrant a "Ghost Rider" sequel, he says, "I'll certainly be there if they call me."

Meanwhile, Elliott plays a more down-to-earth hero in the TNT original movie, "Avenger" debuting April 6. "It was all shot in an amazing part of the world in and around Capetown, South Africa, and they got it all on film, that's the nice part," says Elliott. He plays a small-town lawyer/former Vietnam Special Forces operative who hires himself out to those seeking to avenge the violent murders of loved ones in the edge-of-your-seat film based on Frederick Forsyth's bestselling novel. Now the actor, who's married to Katharine Ross, says he'll be staying put for awhile. "My wife's about to get a knee replacement, so I'm going to be holding hands with her for a few months."

World Trade Center

The Poseidon Adventure bringing tidal waves to a cinema near you in June, and Oliver Stone's World Trade Center, due to open this autumn. According to Stone, the film, starring Nicolas Cage, is an apolitical story of universal human interest. 'This is not about the motives of the terrorists,' he has insisted, 'or who the terrorists were, or the politics of 9/11 in any way. This film is the story of two guys trapped inside and their families on the outside. It's a no-nonsense, austere, verité document of what they went through in those 24 hours.'

Hilariously, a 'film expert' at Purdue University, Indiana, declared that Hollywood has waited a respectable amount of time to tackle such subject matter. Professor William J

Palmer said: 'Just like a spouse mourning a death, there is a proper time to wait before one starts dating. The same is true for Hollywood. With past events, such as the Vietnam War and Watergate, there was a two-year gap before films were produced. The trend is different for 9/11.'

Cage, Smith book trip to 'Time Share'

LOS ANGELES (Hollywood Reporter) - Nicolas Cage and Will Smith are attached to star in and produce "Time Share," a comedy about two fathers who lock horns when they discover their families are booked into the same time share on what should have been their dream vacation.

The Columbia Pictures project is based on a pitch by Mark Steilen, who will receive a payday of about \$1.5 million if the project is produced.

Cage, coming off the biggest film of his career with "National Treasure," had been itching to do a project with Smith, and the two quickly fell for the idea. He has wrapped Columbia's "Ghost Rider" and next films "The Wicker Man" for director Neil LaBute. He next stars in Paramount's "The Weather Man." Smith most recently starred in Columbia's "Hitch." Steilen's most recent pitch, "X-Girls," stars Cameron Diaz and is set up at Fox. He is rewriting "And Spaulding Gets Nothing" for the Walt Disney Co. and has written and directed his script "Basket Case" for Lions Gate. Reuters/Hollywood Reporter

MOVIE OF THE WEEK

SNAKE EYES



Synopsis

During a highly publicised boxing match in Atlantic City, a detective sees the Secretary of Defense being assassinated. Time is against him as he must unravel a deadly conspiracy, deal with the 15,000-strong crowd who could all be possible witnesses, and catch the killer before a tropical hurricane hits the city.

Review

Atmospheric, visually impressive thriller from Mission: Impossible director Brian De Palma, whose creativity bursts through right from a near seamless opening Steadicam shot - the camera pursuing police detective Rick Santoro (Nicolas Cage) into and around the buzzing hive of the Atlantic City Arena for some 20 minutes.

Local boy champ Lincoln Tyler (Stan Shaw) is about to defend his heavyweight title, and Santoro's old mate Kevin Dunne (Gary Sinise) - a Naval Commander in charge of security for the US Secretary of Defense - has wangled ringside seats.

But then the champ goes down, shots are fired, and the Secretary is dead. 14,000 spectators panic, but as the exits are sealed, Santoro is left temporarily in charge, and

responsible for sifting through those 14,000 to uncover what precisely happened, and who fired the fatal bullet.

Although a regrettable degeneration into bog standard, finale run-in ultimately disappoints, this deceptive suspenser has many qualities, and slowly tightens over a superbly gripping first hour.

Cage is on wild and woolly form, and well supported by the other key players - in particular Shaw's guilt-ridden boxer and the rather impressive Carla Gugino (TV's Spin City) - as events unravel from each individual character's viewpoint.
